Akan French Mid-Level

The Introductory French class will introduce 100 key French words and phrases through activities. These activities include: flashcards, matching games, joining exercises, and anagrams.

Four Step Plan

- 1. Have a look at the key topic words with their pictures. Then tear out the flashcards and shuffle them. Put them French side up. Try to say the word and remember what it means. Then turn the card over to check with the English.
- 2. Put the cards English side up and try to say the French word. Try the cards again each day both ways around.
- 3. Try out the activities and games for each topic. This will reinforce your recognition of the key words.
- 4. After you have covered all the topics, you can try the activities in the Round-up section to test your knowledge of all the French words in the book. You can also try shuffling all the 100 flashcards together to see how many you can remember.

Pronunciation Tips

- 1. **r-**a French **r** is produced from the back of the throat; imagine that you are gargling, e.g. **robe** rob (dress)
 - 2. **ch-**like sh in "shirt", e.g. **chaise** shaize (chair)
- 3. **j**, **g** before **e** or **i**-a French **j** or soft **g** is pronounced like the s in "pleasure," and is written as zh in the pronunciation guide, e.g. **jupe** zhewp skirt; **boulangerie** booloñ-zhayree (baker)
 - 4. i-like ee as in "feet," e.g. divan deevoñ (sofa)
 - 5. au-like o as in "over," e.g. chaussure shoh-sewr (shoe)
 - 6. eu-like ur as in "fur," e.g. fleur flur (flower)
 - 7. oi-like wa as in "wax," e.g. poisson pwassoñ (fish)
 - 8. ou-like oo as in "poor," e.g. bonjour boñzhoor (hello)
 - 9. ui-like wee as in "sweet," e.g. cuisiniere cweezeen-yehr (stove)
 - 10. er, ez (at end of word)-like ay as in "play," e.g. nez nay (nose)

Silent Letters

- 1. **h** is always silent
- 2. **t, d, s** are silent at the end of words

Accents

1. There are 4 accents: `, `, ^, ç

Nasal Vowels

1. Nasal vowels are a vowel and an n (an, en, in, on, un)

Masculine/Feminine

In English, the definite article is always "the," e.g. "the table", "the door", "the river". In French, nouns (naming words like "table", "door" or "river") are wither masculine or feminine and the definite article changes accordingly: le, pronounced ler (without saying the r) for masculine or la for feminine. If the noun starts with a vowel or h, the definite artivle is l' for both masculine and feminine. In the plural it is les, pronounced lay, as in les cheveux. It is important as you progress in French to know whether a word is masculine or feminine.

There are lots of words in French that are similar to English such as: le taxi, le bus, le train, le restaurant, etc.
